






## Trends in Length of Stay Singles in Shelters






## Trends in Length of Stay Families in Shelters









### Traditional Service Delivery Model






#### If you are currently NOT housed, when do you expect to be housed?




### Flawed Service Delivery Model

### SSVF: Core Components

- Housing First Model
- Access to supportive services
  - Households demonstrating high needs
- Enrollment to housing: 90 days!
- Client- Centered, Client- Choice

### **ESHC:** Core Components

#### Strategic partnerships

- 8 Sub-grantees
- Access to emergency shelter, housing programs, substance abuse/mental health treatment, etc.

#### Fee for service model

- Case Management
- o \$8.75 per 15 minute unit
- Incentivize agencies to provide quality services to clients

#### Universal/Coordinated Assessment

- Centralized referral process
- Universal assessment

#### Prevention

- 162 Households
- o 362 Persons
- o 127 children
- 82% of households below 30% AMI

#### Rapid Re-housing

- 252 Households
- o 354 Persons
- o 62 children
- 86% of households below 30% of AMI
