Legislative Process



- Legislative Session began January 9
- Consideration of the appropriation of the state and local housing trust fund programs is underway- this is done in the Appropriations Act a/k/a budget bill

Appropriations Update from last Friday, January 26

- On January 31, the full appropriation committees in both House and Senate approved the budgets. So it is no longer just House TED that has proposed zeroing out SHIP-- it is the full House Appropriations Committee
- Appropriation bills are scheduled on Special Order Calendar in both House and Senate for February 7
- The Appropriations bills have to be identical in both the House and Senate in order to become law
- Typically, the House and Senate arrive at an identical budget bill through conference committee
