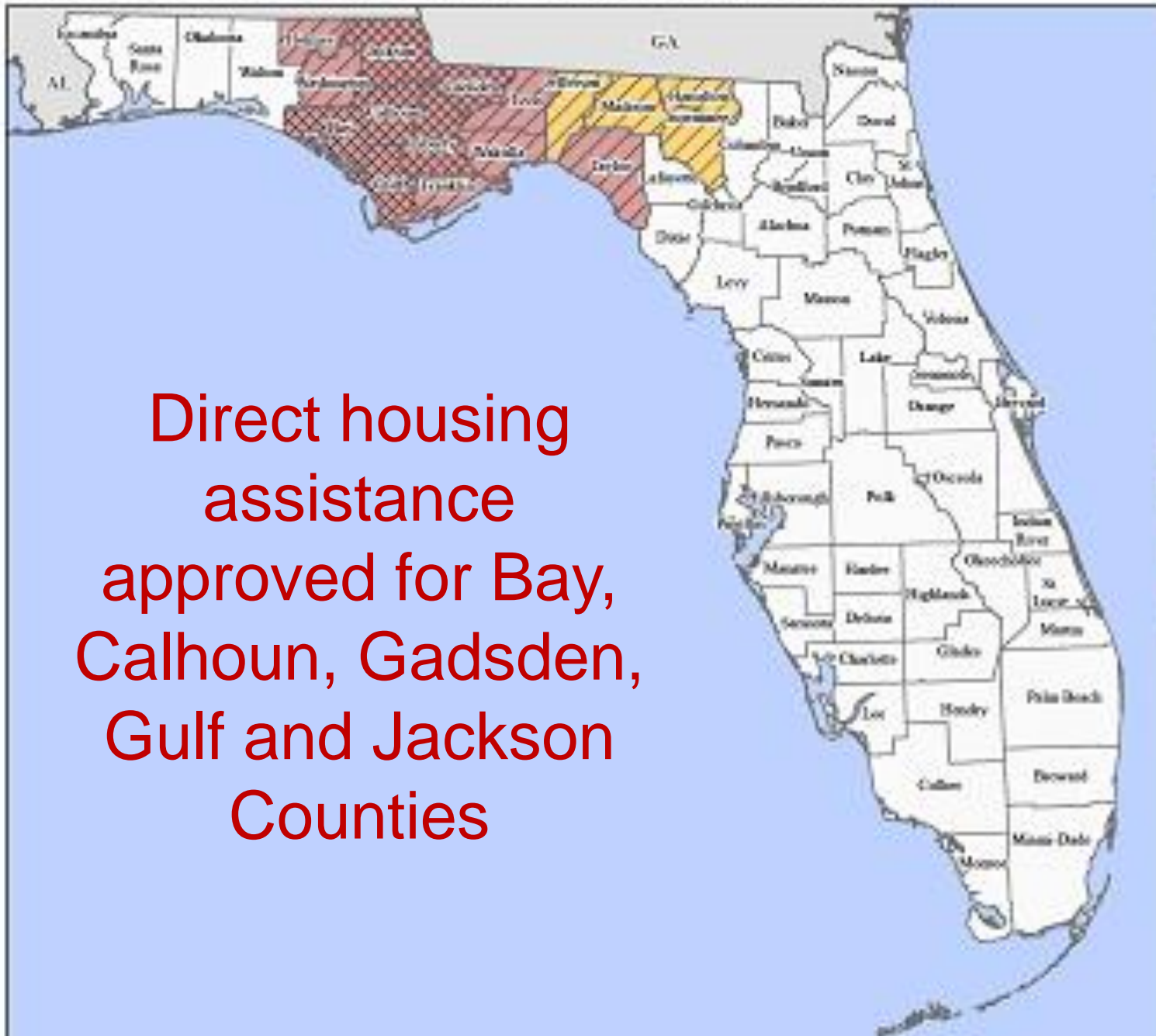

Direct housing assistance approved for Bay, Calhoun, Gadsden, Gulf and Jackson Counties

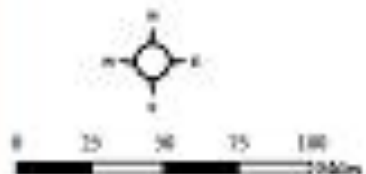


Data Layer/Map Description:

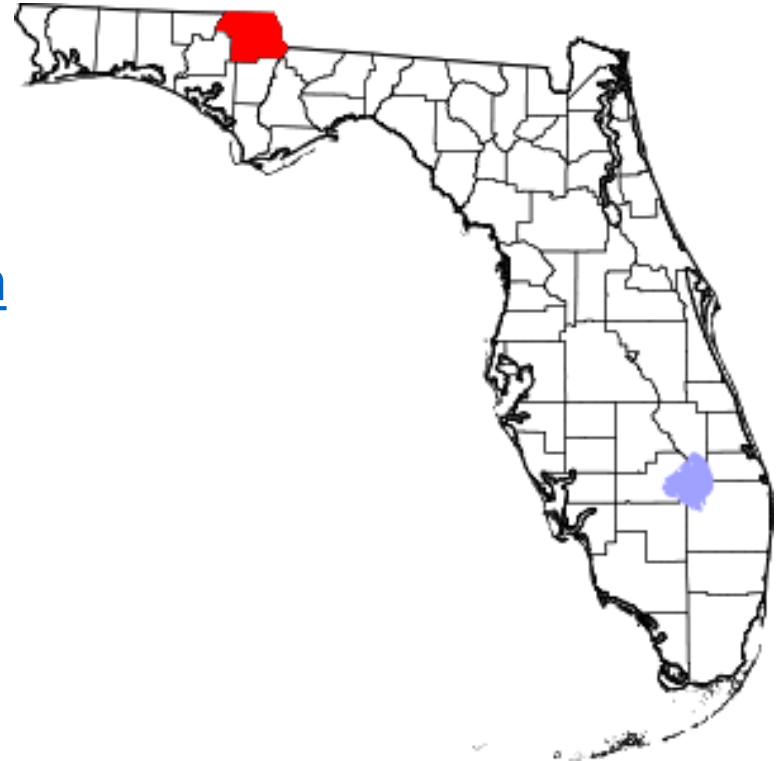
Updates from Hurricane Michael

- 2,500 FEMA trailers en route to Marianna airport for staging
- Currently 719 households in TSA –hotels (938 have checked out)
- 26,130 Households approved for IHP
- 22,507 Households approved for Housing Assistance- \$86.6 disbursed
- Avg HA award \$3,336
- Rental Assistance- 6,829 owners/10,455 renters
- 63,491 inspections completed by 47 inspectors
- 98.2% complete with inspections

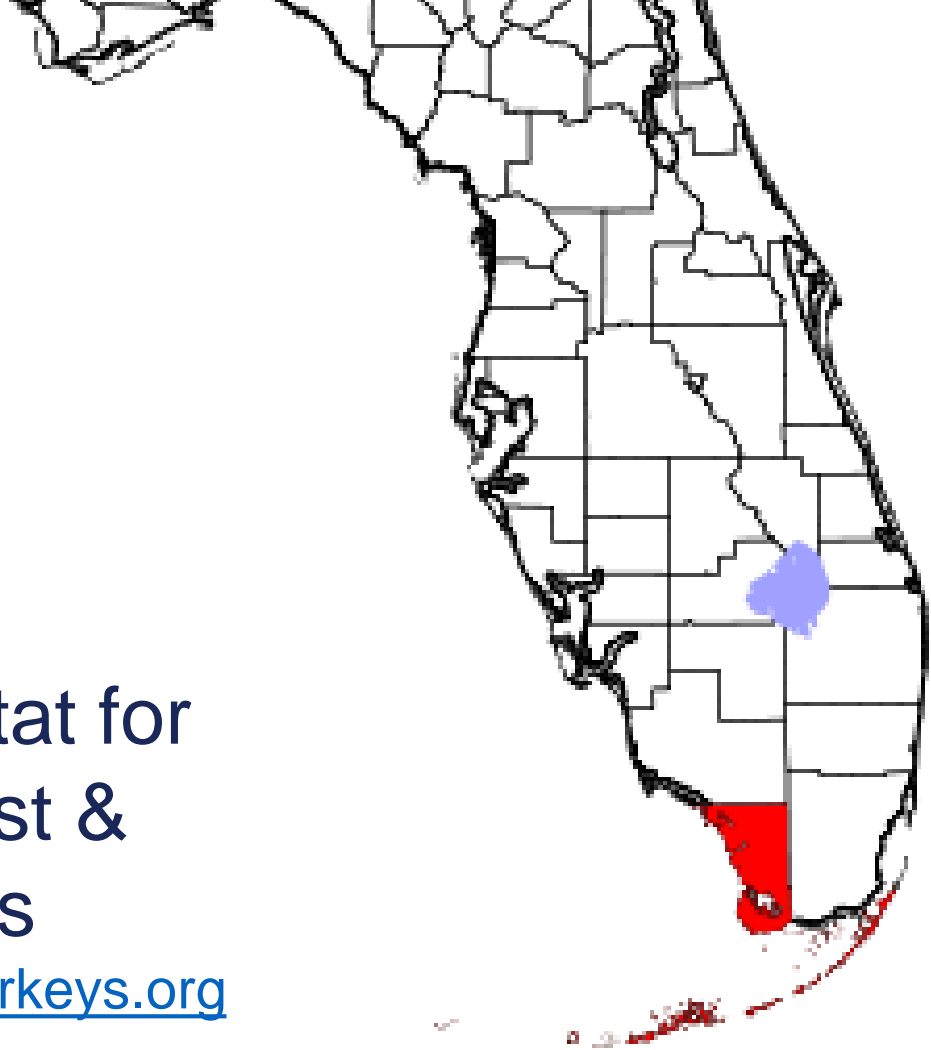

- Repairs to over 20 homes
- Working on 6 more homes
- 10 new construction homes: homeowners move in by December 1st
