- 41 Long Term Recovery sub-grantees assisted 48 counties affected by Irma

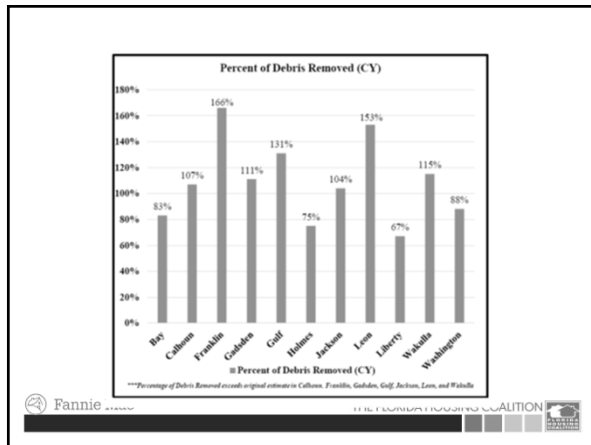

- US House passed bill HR 268- Supplemental
- FEMA SITUATION REPORT:
  - 7,897 survivors eligible for TSA
  - 605 checked in (total pop. 1,862); 1,377 checked out
  - 1,183 IA applicants approved for Direct Housing
  - 323 temporary housing units Leased-in
