# National Update: From NLIHC

- From NLIHC: A bipartisan group of 8 Senators have introduced a **\$13.6 billion disaster relief package, including \$1.06 billion in CDBG-DR funds**. The bill also includes \$610 million in Nutrition Assistance for Puerto Rico. **SEE CALL TO ACTION ATTACHED**
- House Financial Services Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations will hold a hearing on Tuesday, March 26 at 10:00 am entitled, “The Administration of Disaster Recovery Funds in the Wake of Hurricanes Harvey, Irma, and Maria.” The hearing will take place in 2128 Rayburn House Office Building and can be livestreamed [here](#). Witnesses have not yet been announced.
- HUD Secretary Carson [told](#) reporters that HUD is still working on the rules regarding the mitigation-specific CDBG-DR funding included in the disaster recovery package passed in February 2017. He stated those rules should be released in May.

- FEMA officials say they're working to get [more](#) temporary housing into Gulf County, where there are currently 28 families still in need.
- LTRO's--The following groups have formed or are forming:
  - Bay County Long Term Recovery Group
  - Citizens of Gulf County Recovery Team
  - Liberty Strong Long Term Recovery Group
  - North Florida Inland Long Term Recovery Group
  - Washington County Long Term Organization. In addition, two other long-term recovery groups will be coming online in Gadsden and Franklin counties.
