





What is Homesharing?

- 1. Homeowner (or person with space to share) lists space in their home for rent to live together with a housemate.
- Housemate pays monthly rent, which may be reduced in exchange for help around the house.
- Homesharing often results in unexpected companionship and other social benefits.



Who Homesharing Helps



Older adults and empty nesters



Undergrad and graduate students



Teachers, volunteers and other front-line workers



People displaced by natural disasters

Homesharing translates into real impact

More resilient, connected and prepared communities

More secure than Craigslist or word-of-mouth and based on compatibility

Provides flexible options for both evacuees and first responders

Comparison: Housing Solutions



Inaction

- ✓ Creates or increases societal burden
- ✓ Expensive



New Construction

- ✓ Expensive
- ✓ Time-intensive
- √ Not scalable



Homesharing

- ✓ Affordable
- ✓ Immediate & Flexible
- ✓ Scalable

A Simple Solution

Q: How can we address these housing, financial, aging and other challenges - such as disaster recovery efforts - at the same time?

A: It's as easy as something most of us have done: having a roommate.



...But with Gaps

Sharing a home is personal, with potential for risk or conflict.

Gaps in traditional homesharing include:

- Matching: the ability to screen potential roommates for compatibility
- Communication: help preventing and resolving misunderstandings
- Protection: for the homesharing arrangement and each person's belongings






Example: Home Share Oregon

Funding and Resources

There are many ways to fund a homesharing program. Silvernest partners have resourced their programs in the following ways:

- Innovation grants
- Private donors
- County/city resources via RFP
- Dollars allocated for affordable housing preservation or foreclosure prevention

All Silvernest partnerships come with customized support for launching a homesharing program and making it successful.



Who Could Benefit from Homesharing?

- Natural disaster evacuees and those assisting with recovery who need a place to live
- Homeowners with ADUs
- AAAs/ADRCs who are focused on helping their clients age in place
- Nonprofits who serve homeowners/renters avoid foreclosure and eviction
- Governments who aim to build more workforce housing, and decrease displacement and gentrification
- Healthcare companies or foundations who want to reduce isolation and improve health outcomes, and help older adults access more in home care
- Cities who want to increase access to more affordable housing stock
- Financial wellness entities who want to improve their clients' income or financial stability
- And more!





New: COVID-Conscious Features



Communication is key

- New onboarding questions let users indicate preferences and safety practices
- COVID-Conscious listing badge lets users communicate safety protocol and identify others who are likeminded


Background Screens

About background screens:

- Can be completed proactively or at the request of another user
- One-time fee of \$29.99
- Results are good for 90 days and unlimited listings
- Screen covers:

- National and county criminal search
- Eviction history and civil search
- Global watch list search

- Sex offender registry search
- Social Security number verification

Homesharing-Ready Insurance

Coverage includes:*


- Up to \$100,000 in protection for the home against damage a housemate might cause
- Up to \$10,000 in protection for the housemate's property from accidental damage
- No deductible, no separate application process
- Coverage kicks in when first rent payment is processed through Silvernest




Rent Calculator

No guesswork required

- Onboarding wizard provides rent recommendation based on location, size and amenities
- Homeowners have option to increase monthly rent to incorporate 5%
 Silvernest fee
