




September 10, 2017 Hurricane Irma Anniversary





Hurricane Irma: September 10, 2017



According to the most recent Hurricane Irma claims data from the Florida Office of Insurance Regulation in January of this year, more than 1 million Irma claims have been filed - 909,321 of those being residential property and 61,518 commercial – totaling almost \$17.5 billion in insured losses.

The 2017 Atlantic Hurricane Season: "Disaster displacement, one of the biggest humanitarian challenges of the 21st century."

- United States Total displacement in 2017: 1.7 million according to the US Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). The Atlantic hurricane season, especially hurricanes Irma, Harvey and Maria, affected the US.
- Hurricane Irma accounted for 202,000 new displacements, mainly in Florida.
- Cuba- The highest displacement from Hurricane Irma was in Cuba where 1.7 million new displacements occurred.
- In 2017, Hurricane Harvey resulted in 848,000 displacements



Climate Risk and Real Estate


- Large institutional investors know they must assess and manage climate-related risks if they are to meet their fiduciary duties to clients and beneficiaries.
- Climate change is already influencing real estate markets, with properties exposed to sea level rise in the United States selling at a 7 percent discount to those with less exposure.
- U.S. markets most exposed to sea level rise include New York, San Francisco, Miami, Fort Lauderdale, and Boston.

Billion-Dollar Weather and Climate Disasters in the US, 1980 to 2018

The number of weather- and climate-related disasters that cost \$1 billion or more has increased in recent years. Growing disaster costs can be attributed to expanding population and wealth, and continued development in coastal and flood-prone areas, as well as climate change.





↑3.3 millimeters per year







Strategies that provide critical needs when a facility loses power or other services.






Backup Power – Mid to High Cost Generator


