

The Florida Division of Emergency Management has posted a career opportunity for the Disaster Housing Recovery Coordinator for the State of Florida.

The Disaster Housing Recovery Coordinator is a professional position in the Bureau of Recovery's Individual Assistance Unit. The Coordinator is responsible for coordinating programs related to the post-disaster housing needs of survivors in Federally-declared and non-declared disasters. This position engages with federal, state, and local governments, non-governmental organizations, and private-sector to develop plans, strategies, and procedures which promote housing availability, equity, and resiliency across the State of Florida following a natural or man-made disaster. This position also provides technical assistance to local governments in the development of local housing strategies.

This position is an OPS position (\$30 to \$35/hour depending on qualifications) that will close on 11/23/2021.

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
